As in previous years, the year 2022 has shown us that in carrying out public benefit activities, apart from thorough planning, it is also necessary to respond to current events happening around us.

2022 RESULTS

In the past year, we managed to respond meaningfully to the needs that arose from the development of the pandemic, geopolitical, as well as social situations. We also managed to increase the share of our public service projects and attract new partners whose ideas and contributions serve as an inspiration to us.

We have subjected every activity and project of ours to tests of public benefit, cost-effectiveness, and purposefulness, while we have been and will continue to prioritize ensuring that they have a social and inclusive dimension at the same time as avoiding any negative environmental impact on the surroundings.

The annual report includes the results of our activities, and an overview of the areas we focus on, as well as a detailed description of our projects, long-term partnerships, and grant programs in 2022. We have managed to achieve our goals and allocate almost EUR 900 000. A portion of these resources was allocated to providing immediate help, while another portion helped to create long-term opportunities in the areas we support.

Year 2022 in numbers

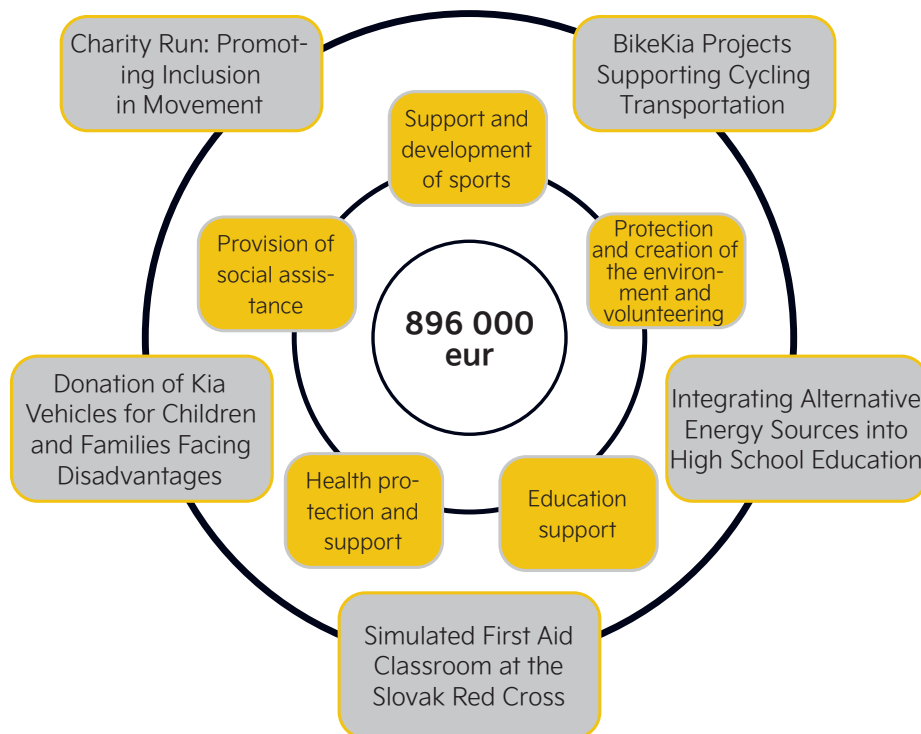
In 2022, the Foundation continued its program priorities focused on green mobility, education, and community support, redistributing over EUR 896,000 for projects throughout Slovakia

The Foundation implemented its public-benefit projects, continued its long-term partnerships, and supported activities of nonprofit organizations, communities, disadvantaged athletes, and educational institutions through three traditional grant programs.

In 2022, the Foundation provided targeted and effective assistance in the areas of humanitarian aid, education support, environmental protection, and inclusive sports. With consideration for people with social or health dis-

advantages, as well as environmental impact, we were able to successfully implement 108 public-benefit projects.

MOBILITY

Supporting mobility is a significant topic for us. We have implemented several projects in the areas of social assistance and health support, as well as environmental and sports support.

We donated ten vehicles to organizations providing early intervention and hospice care services.

In collaboration with the local government, we have built these additional significant projects:

- Bikesharing in Žilina
- Pumptrack Dolný Kubín
- Cycling path "Terchovská dolina"

Supporting mobility in ensuring social and healthcare services

Vehicle donation represented a significant project in the past year, through which we had the opportunity to meet amazing people whose assistance and dedication in providing early intervention and hospice care services is truly admirable. It was an honor for us to help in facilitating their secure transportation.

In April, the children's mobile hospices Svetielko nádeje, Svetielko pomoci, Pod krídlami Dominiky, and Simeon hospice center in Bratislava received a new Kia Ceed SW vehicles along with winter tires, with the Foundation covering the annual expenses for insurance and service inspections. We also provided these organizations with safe and comfortable car seats for transporting pediatric patients to healthcare facilities.

Another six Kia Ceed SW vehicles were delivered to early intervention centers in Bratislava, Trnava, Trenčín, Hnúšťa, Košice, and Humenné. Chairman of the Association of Early Intervention Providers and Supporters, Vladislav Matej, has acknowledged the contribution of this project: „I perceive the support from the Kia Foundation through the donation of new vehicles as crucial and significant. Families will receive early intervention assistance, and support providers will be able to manage the logistics of supporting these families better.“

For both early intervention services and hospice care, mobility is crucial. The new vehicles for the staff will also increase families' access to these services, allowing the centers to assist more efficiently, reliably, and on a larger scale.

Our goal is to help eliminate barriers in the provision of social services between service providers and patients.

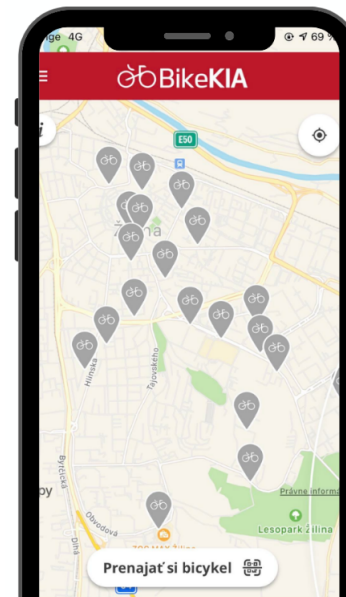


The popular bikesharing service has once again excited residents of Žilina

The fourth season of the free public bikesharing service has brought new features and an increased interest in rentals, up by 33 % compared to the previous season. 9 virtual stations and 22 bicycles have been added to the existing infrastructure, with their locks being charged by solar panels.

The number of users of this service has exceeded 40,000. Throughout the nine-month season, the shared bicycles collectively covered a total distance of over 220,000 kilometers, resulting in significant CO2 savings compared to individual car transportation. Users had the opportunity to rent bicycles for free for 30 minutes, with the option of re-renting them.

Since 2019, bike sharing has become a natural part of public transportation, and its popularity among people confirms that sustainable mobility in Žilina has its justification.



Foundation's fourth pumptrack circuit in the Žilina region

A new sports facility has been built on Okružná Street in Dolný Kubín - a pumptrack circuit. Over 7 weeks, an originally unused area was transformed into a more than 120 meters long and 2 meters wide track consisting of waves and banked turns, designed for all-wheeled sports - bicycles, scooters, skateboards, and roller-blades.

- ▶ **Pumptrack is an excellent and easy way to improve technical riding skills and also serves as a foundation for off-road riding. ▶**



A new cycling path Terchovská Dolina has been added to the map of Slovakia

The construction of this cycling path was completed in 2022, connecting a total of 9 cadastral areas over a distance of more than 23 kilometers from Žilina to Terchová.

The construction process was carried out by the Regional Tourism Organization Malá Fatra, and it was initiated in 2014. The funding for the project, totaling EUR 6.3 million, was secured from the Integrated Region Operational Program.

Foundation supported the project by contributing funds up to 5 % of the total eligible construction costs, which surpassed EUR 313,000 in 3 years of partnership.

▶ The cycling route will contribute to safe and eco-friendly commuting of residents, expand cycling opportunities, and promote tourism in the beautiful surrounding of Terchovská dolina. ▶

The primary objective of the new cycling path is to mitigate the congestion on the busy road to reduce potentially hazardous interactions between cyclists and motor vehicles. Another aim is to enhance the appeal of cycling as a mode of transportation by setting up charging stations tailored for electric bicycles.

An distinctive aspect of this infrastructure project is the incorporation of bridge structures. On the path leading from the Žilina Water Pound through the village of Varín, a total of ten substantial bridges, each spanning 55 meters, have been constructed.

These design elements draw inspiration from traditional folk architecture, resulting in a seamless integration that harmonizes perfectly with the natural surroundings.



EDUCATION

We provide a long-term support of the education with focus on children's technical skills development:

- Establishing technical workshops in kindergartens and procuring teaching materials to enhance technical education in elementary and high schools
- Organization of a free children summer camp Automotive Junior Academy
- Popularization of sciences in elementary schools
- Support of simulation and educational center of first aid.

The Foundation helped to build 9 additional technical kindergartens in the region

The objective of the technical kindergartens is to illustrate the splendor of the technical world and offer children opportunities to nurture their curiosity and creativity. A strong emphasis is placed on sensory exploration, hands-on experimentation, and the creation of projects using natural materials.

One of the technical corners was established at the Primary School with Kindergarten in Teplička nad Váhom. Professor Iveta Radičová, who has been the project guarantor of this nationwide initiative since 2014, also graciously accepted the invitation to the workshop's opening.

Since 2019, the Foundation has been actively involved in supporting the establishment of technical corners in 17 kindergartens within the Žilina region.

Talented students from across the region

Since 2018, the Foundation has financed the acquisition of educational aids in the form of Unimat Technics sets for technical workshops in a total of 42 primary schools. These construction sets facilitate the assembly of 8 different types of devices for woodworking, plastics, and soft material processing. These include a bench drill, horizontal milling machine, lathe, and vertical drill.

In addition to maintaining this project, we also initiated the "Skilled Class" competition for schools. Schools submitted photos of their technical education projects, and the winning classes, determined through social media voting, were provided with materials to further their work in their workshops. Additionally, they were offered the unique opportunity to observe car production up close, directly within the facilities of the Foundation's founder.



New Equipment for Technical Schools

The Mechanical School in Kysucké Nové Mesto has acquired a hydrogen-powered car, a fuel cell development kit, and renewable energy storage boxes through a grant from the Foundation.

The Unified School in Martin has enhanced its professional educational curriculum by introducing a training cell equipped with an industrial articulated robot. This robot will serve primarily for theoretical instruction and will be predominantly operated by students pursuing mechanical engineering disciplines.

Kia Foundation's Automotive Junior Academy

Foundation successfully launched a free two-week Automotive Junior Academy. A total of 29 children participated in this daily camp.

The camp started at the Faculty of Management and Informatics of the University of Žilina, where children engaged in assembling robotic cars. It then progressed to the Education Center at Kia Slovakia in Gbeľany, offering participants the chance to assemble car rearview mirrors and partake in skill-testing activities.

The culmination of the camp featured robotic car races held at the University of Žilina.

The aim of the day camp is to spark children's interest in technical education, acquaint them with studying and working in the automotive industry, and demonstrate that the fusion of hands-on skills and solid knowledge can also be enjoyable.

The Foundation rewarded active teachers

The Foundation actively supports education in the region by providing licenses for intelligent educational software. On Teacher's Day, the Foundation symbolically honored those educators who utilize the software most extensively in their teaching.

"The software greatly aids us teachers as well. With its assistance, we can create tests, assign homework to students, and even perform assessments. Moreover, we can access students' results, enabling us to identify areas where they've encountered the most challenges. This allows us to evaluate their work, analyze the time spent, and observe their commitment to learning," expressed a teacher from the Primary School with Kindergarten in Bánová.

Promotion of Science in Elementary Schools

The Foundation has contributed to the acquisition of Scientific Courier sets, which were taken to primary schools as part of the European Researchers' Night project. These sets contained supplies and tools for conducting interactive experiments aimed at enhancing regular teaching methods. Additionally, the Foundation's project coordinators volunteered and actively participated in events in Žilina.

Simulation and Education Center for First Aid

In October, an exceptional facility dedicated to the design and execution of first aid simulations was established within the previously unused attic areas of the Slovak Red Cross in Žilina.

This innovative center serves as a platform for individuals without medical backgrounds, aspiring caregivers, volunteers, as well as students pursuing fields such as healthcare, safety engineering, and firefighting. Here, they can acquire fresh insights through hands-on experiences. The Foundation played a role in procuring technical equipment for a section of the interior.

COMMUNITY

We contribute to cultivating a contemporary and well-functioning society by engaging in activities that promote the welfare of others, demonstrate genuine interest in their well-being, and provide assistance to those who are vulnerable and underprivileged. We focus on the following initiatives:

- The "Inspiration through Movement" grant program
- The "Green Communities" grant program
- The "Advent Calendar" grant program
- The restoration of the areas surrounding the watercourses of the Kysuca and Varínka rivers
- The organization of a charity run by the Kia Slovakia Foundation
- Support for the establishment of an inclusive playground
- Assistance for pediatric patients at Žilina hospital
- Provision of computers for organizations operating in the social sector

The Advent Calendar grant program spotlighted the theme of mutual assistance

Within this grant program, 24 projects centered around health protection and social assistance were funded, with over EUR 11,000 allocated for distribution.

The Čmeliakovo civic association, securing the 25th position, was granted a donation of 232 euros generated from the sale of plastic bottle caps collected by employees of Kia Slovakia s. r. o.

Examples of projects from grant program Advent Calendar:

- ▶ **The goal of the grant program is to cover the expenses of medical treatment or healthcare support, while also offering material assistance to families and children facing social disadvantages.** ▶

Didactic Aids for Children in Trstená

Civil association MÁŠA, in cooperation with the Community Center in Trstená, supports and develops activities aimed at improving the quality of life for socially and physically disadvantaged citizens.

During community meetings of families with children with Down syndrome, they practice activities that help develop their gross motor skills. With the grant from the Foundation, the association purchased educational aids and toys that will assist children in their psychomotor development.

Special Compensatory Aids for the Hearing Impaired

The organization Regional Center for the Deaf ANEPS Žilina implemented a project titled "(Un)Hear, See, and Understand" with financial support from the Foundation. The aim was to provide special compensatory aids for sound transmission to individuals with hearing impairments, particularly to introduce this aid to people with partial hearing loss. The project also ensured sign language interpretation for the deaf during individual training sessions.

Canistherapy for Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder

Regular therapies play a crucial role in the lives of children with autism as they have a positive impact on their psychomotor development. The financial resources from the Foundation's grant program were utilized by the Society for Assistance to People with Autism Kysuce for an intervention involving specially trained dogs. These animals not only become companions in children's play but also help patients learn responsibility and thoughtfulness



Grant Program 'Inspiration through Movement' Provides Opportunities for People with Disabilities to Engage in Sports

The goal of the grant scheme was to improve conditions for athletes with physical or mental disabilities. A total of 29 projects were implemented across Slovakia, with over EUR 10,000 being redistributed for this purpose.

Among the successful founders are members of the Slovakia Union of Physically Disabled Athletes, the Slovak Union of Athletes with Intellectual Disabilities, the Slovak Association of Visually Impaired Athletes, the Slovak Paralympic Committee, and the Slovak Deaflympic Committee.

Examples of the 'Inspiration through Movement' Grant Program include:

Modification of Table Tennis for Visually Impaired Athletes

The Foundation collaborated with the City Sports Club for Athletes with Low Vision and Blind Athletes in Žilina, as well as the Slovak Association of Visually Impaired Athletes. Grants were used to purchase new tables, protective gloves, and rackets for 'showdown,' which is a modified table tennis game designed for visually impaired athletes."

Exceptional Athletes with Disabilities

Athletes from the civil association 'Smile On Me' train in various sports disciplines, including swimming, winter sports, cycling, taekwondo, athletics, yoga, and bowling. Sports equipment was purchased through a grant to support the development and preparation of sports activities for competitive events for athletes with special needs.



Green Communities Grant Program has significantly contributed to the advancement of volunteering in the Žilina region

In 2022, our primary focus was on supporting projects related to environmental protection and creation. Through a lottery draw, we selected 26 projects, out of which a total of 25 environmentally-oriented activities were implemented, amounting to nearly EUR 50,000 in funding.

▶ We create opportunities for community organizing with a focus on environmental development, revitalization of public spaces, cultural heritage, and school gardens. ▶

Examples of projects from the 'Inspiration through Movement' Grant Program include:

Sidewalk Revitalization with a Fairytale Forest in Jasenská Dolina

The civil association Jasenská Dolina succeeded in reconstructing the beloved fairytale path near the ski slope, thanks to the grant. This has increased the safety of cyclists, runners, and child visitors.

Community Garden in the Heart of Žilina

Thanks to the civil association Papavero, a public community garden has been established in the Hliny district of Žilina. Besides growing crops, the space also serves as a place for active relaxation for parents and children and as a venue for organizing practical workshops in the field of environmental education.

Revitalization of Frambor Park

The revitalization of the polluted public space under the stands in Žilina is taking place under the auspices of the civic association Žilinský Skrášľovací Spolok. Thanks to the grant from the Foundation, they have implemented the planting of ornamental trees, a grass mixture, and perennials.

Generational Trees for Višňové Village

The civil association Terka used financial resources for planting trees in the village of Višňové. In addition to providing food and shelter for various bird species and insects, the new greenery will serve as insulation in an environment burdened by road construction.



Humanitarian Aid to Residents of Ukraine on the Territory of Slovakia

The Foundation promptly responds to exceptional situations and strives to mitigate their negative impacts on society. Following the COVID-19 pandemic, it was the military conflict in Ukraine that led to the arrival of several thousand people from Ukraine to Slovakia.

In this context, the Foundation provided a donation of EUR 50,000 to Slovak Red Cross to ensure the provision of humanitarian materials, particularly in the areas near the Ukrainian border.

Revitalizácia okolia vodných tokov rieky Kysuca a Varínka

With the support of the VÚB Foundation, the nonprofit organization For Society, and the Vodnár Diving Club, we managed to collect 850 kg of waste from the surroundings of the Kysuca River.

In cooperation with the Administration of the Malá Fatra National Park, we participated in the cleaning of the Varínka River, which is an area of European significance and belongs to the system of protected areas of EU member countries (Natura 2 000).



Kia Slovakia Foundation Charity Run

In May, the Foundation organized a sports community event called "Inclusion in Motion," with the aim of raising awareness about athletes with intellectual disabilities and improving their sports conditions.

In addition to running, participants had the opportunity to try riding a handbike or playing adaptive table tennis for visually impaired athletes. With a charitable purpose, a total of 368 children and adults took part in the event, combining both in-person and virtual participation.

By collectively running a total of 2,700 kilometers, they supported the movement of Special Olympics Slovakia, to

which the Foundation provided a donation of EUR 10,000 to support sports training for children with special needs.

"We are pleased to have been a part of this exceptional event, still rare in Slovakia, where there was no distinction between the healthy and those with disabilities, and we could all spend an amazing day together, full of movement and joy," said Mr. Marek Smižanský from the Platform of Families and Children with Disabilities.



First Inclusive Playground in Žilina

The Foundation provided financial support for the construction of the first barrier-free playground with elements of inclusion in Žilina. The structure serves child visitors without distinction based on their abilities. It includes play elements such as a special carousel, a swing, and an elevated sandbox for children with mobility issues. The area also features educational boards with Braille writing and sign language.

Support for Pediatric Patients at Žilina Hospital

At the end of 2022, the Foundation succeeded in providing a communication system for the ward dedicated to older children at the Faculty Hospital with Outpatient Clinic in Žilina.

The system was installed at patient bedsides, in nurses' stations, and in social facilities. The communication device offers a variety of useful features for both patients and healthcare personnel.

100 Computers Find a New Home in Senior Care Facilities

During the Advent period, we distributed refurbished computers donated by Kia Slovakia s.r.o. to a total of 31 organizations in the field of senior care and social services in the Žilina region.

Despite being in good condition, the computers were retired due to regular hardware upgrades. We ensured that all sensitive information was removed from the computers, and each one received new operating memory and internal storage before being donated.

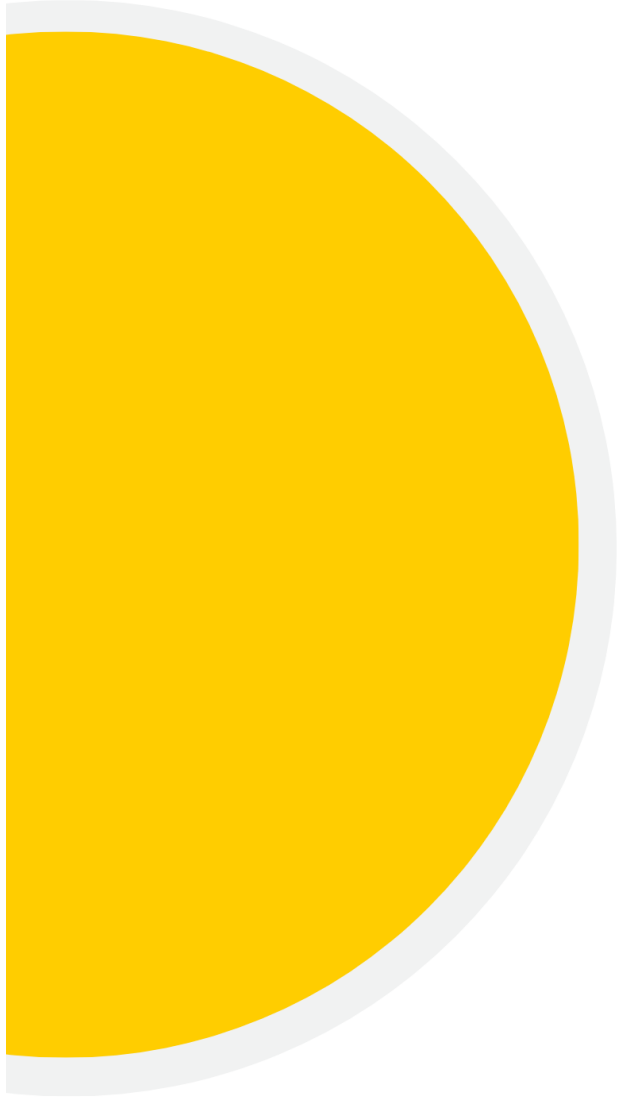
